## HONORING THE FAMILY OF MARIA CULLITON

As chairs for the Foundation's Walk4Life in 2003, they would have made Maria very proud. Since the Walk's inception in 2002, they have placed consistently

in the top 10 fundraising teams out of over 200. The Culliton family has made their commitment to the Foundation. True leaders, each one has an important role in furthering the Foundation goals of advancing scientific research and providing people with ALS with exceptional clinical care and support services.

The "Hope Through Caring" Award was established in 1988 to honor those committed to raising funds and awareness about ALS.

Prior to his retirement after 41 years at Illinois Tool Works, Inc. (ITW), Jim was chairman, CEO, president and executive vice president of the company based in Glenview, Illinois.
